

Guidelines for Groups

Participating in the Catholic Youth Rally for Christ

Registration:

- Group leaders need to send in **ONLY** the group registration form(s) and the payment;
- Group leaders should keep individual registrations/Medical Release/Parent Permission forms of participants for their own records - do **NOT** send these forms to the Diocese;
- The \$20 registration fee must be paid by **ALL** participants - including all adults and youth;
- Groups may only register in advance - **NO WALK-INS**.

Chaperones:

- Each group must have a minimum of 1 chaperone for every 7 teens attending (e.g. if your group has 7 teens attending, you must provide 1 chaperone; if your group has 16 teens attending, you must provide 3 chaperones; if your group has 2 teens attending, you must provide 1 chaperone);
- Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age;
- Groups should screen each chaperone as is diocesan policy;
- Chaperones must follow all rules set by the Middle School Rally team;

FAQ's

Q - What do I do with the individual registration (with medical release/parent permission) forms that I collect from the teens?

A - Transfer the necessary info onto the group registration form then keep them for your records.

Q - Do chaperones have to pay the \$20 Rally fee?

A - Yes. All adults must pay. Groups may choose to pay this fee for the chaperones.

Q - If I have a teen in my group that decides she wants to come at the last minute, can I bring her along and pay for her as a walk-in?

A - Sorry, there are no walk-ins allowed. Please send in registrations by Oct 15th, 2008.

Q - Who do I make the check out to?

A - Make checks out to the Diocese of Madison. We prefer that you collect money from each individual then send only 1 check for the total amount from your group.
