

Chalice Case Dimensions, Information, and Construction

Fr. Paul Arinze of St. Joseph's in Dodgeville has indicated that two of his Knights of Columbus, John Aschliman and Mike Seman, would be willing to make the cases for the vocations chalice for other parishes at a reasonable cost. They did mention that it would be nice if they can make a quantity at a time to save cost and time.

The dimensions of the chalice/paten case (made of wood and glass) are as follows:

Depth = 5.1/2"

Height= 7.1/4"

Length = 12.1/3"

Glass front: Approx. 12" x 6. 3/8"

The inside is cut to fit according to John and Mike.

The chalice catalog number from Stempers 2005-2006 catalog is page 313, Item# A-2504S. The listed price is \$340.00

John and Mike will be happy to work on the case for the chalice for \$60-\$65 per case (material and labor included). They will fit everything that they did with the chalice case for St. Joseph's in Dodgeville.
